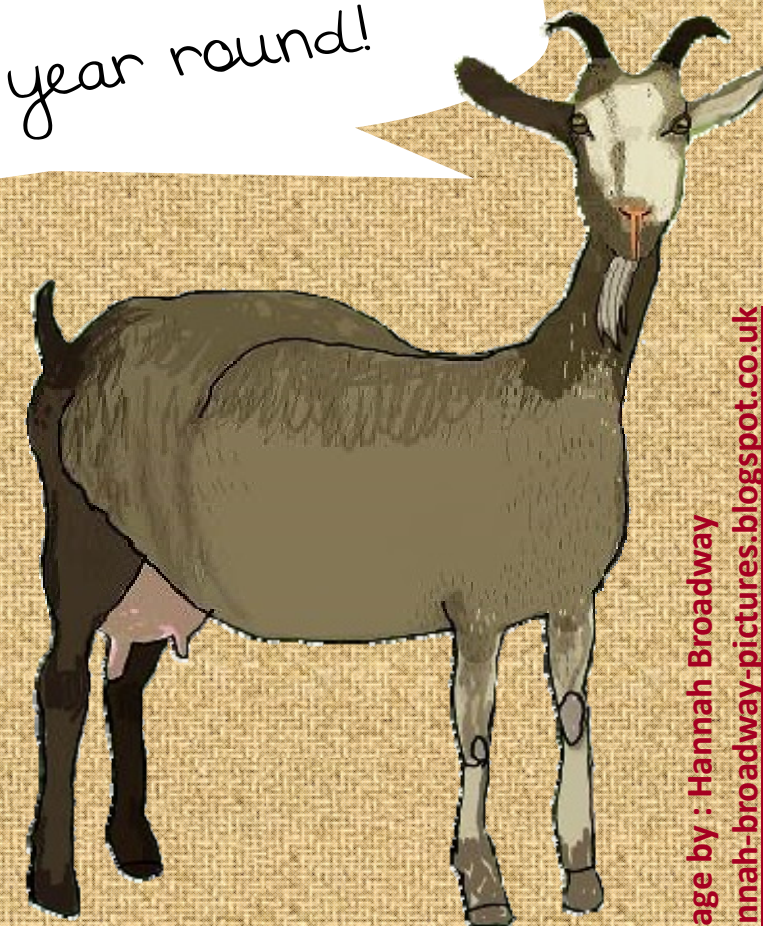

# What we do...

St Werburghs City Farm is well known for our quirky inner-city smallholding and our award winning Café. In fact, we engage 15,000 people through our seasonal events and site facilities and welcome more than 40,000 visitors to the Farm site each year. **But what most people don't know is that we manage 4 diverse sites across Ashley Vale and offer a range of services, that support and engage more than 3,000 disadvantaged people each year.**

From work experience for disaffected youth; volunteer opportunities for unemployed adults; training placements for adults with learning difficulties; play opportunities for children facing disadvantage; free activities for families on low-incomes; educational trips and community events, we are more than just a farm, we are a vital community resource accessible to all.



# How to help...

**The Farm offers a great community resource for all, seven days a week, all year round. We offer a 'entertainment' lifeline to many local parents, and are instrumental in making sure that Ashley Vale is a great place to live. If you live locally, or if you visit us regularly, why not support us with a regular donation of £5 per month. After all, what else does £5 get you these days? A pint in the local pub, a small take-out pizza, 1/2 a cinema ticket? Well let me tell you, we can make £5 go a long way...**

## A £5 gift would pay for:

- Ingredients to teach disadvantaged parents how to cook a healthy meal for their family
- Seeds and compost to engage adults with learning difficulties in a growing activity at the Community Garden
- A days feed, straw and water to keep our pigs happy
- Enough hand soap and green towels for 30 visiting school children

**Impressed? Just imagine the difference that you, and a few friends or neighbours would make if you all gifted £5 a month, for example:**

**£15** feeds our goats for an entire week

**£50** provides support to engage a vulnerable young person in educational, inspiring and fun outdoor activities

**£100** purchases waterproof jackets and trousers that will be used by more than 30 disadvantaged children over 3 years

**£300** enables six adults suffering mental distress to take part in six weeks of outdoor, therapeutic support sessions

**£500** allows us to refurbish the toilet to offer improved access and better baby changing facilities
